

***THE PLAN...What Does This Mean to Me?***

The planned improvements will provide new spaces that increase opportunities for community use - a new meeting room with an adjacent Hospitality Courtyard; an additional events lawn, smaller and more private than the amphitheater; a prep kitchen for increased and better food and beverage service. The new facilities will also generate an increase in earned income to help support The Center's mission. The endowment will provide a cornerstone of support for its education, cultural and presenting programs.

In 2000, The Center's board and staff got together with Maui business leaders and planners, and took a good look at how The Center is used and how to better serve the community. These facility master-planning sessions led to a feasibility study and the decision to undertake a capital/endowment fundraising campaign.
